The Bedford Oak

The town is comprised of three unincorporated hamlets, Bedford Hills, Bedford Village and Katonah. Each has its own identity with a rich history and wonderful resources. Each hamlet features a library, which is open to all, and is served by its own fire department. All Bedford residents are welcome to use the facilities of our three town parks for swimming, picnicking, and a broad range of other activities. We are fortunate to have scores of museums, nature trails, horse trails, conservancy organizations and service clubs.

HISTORY

The town of Bedford was founded on December 23, 1680, when 22 Puritans from Stamford, Connecticut, purchased a tract of land three miles square known as the "Hopp Ground" from Chief Katonah and several other Native Americans for coats, blankets, wampum and cloth. Rich in history, some minor landmarks in Bedford are centered on the Village Green, as well as having Westchester County's oldest government building, the Bedford court house.

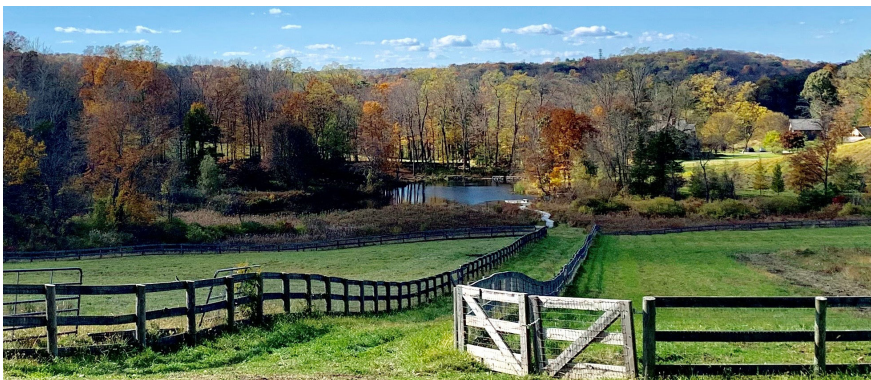
