

## About

Located on Connecticut's "Gold Coast," Darien is a suburban community with excellent schools, an active town center, and involved residents. Darien offers unspoiled land and clear waters. Those who have come to live here have been careful stewards of its architectural and natural heritage while enjoying the resources of a modern community.

## Education

85% of the total student population attends public school. Darien has five elementary schools:

- Hindley, Holmes, Ox Ridge, Royle, and Tokeneke Elementary School
- Middlesex Middle School (grades 6-8)
- Darien High School (among the top ranked in the State annually) Darien's graduation rate is 99 percent, which U.S. News reports is well above state median. The school ranks six in the state in both college readiness index and college curriculum breadth index. The school ranks No. 1 in math and reading proficiency and 12 in math and reading performance.

Total enrollment in public schools in Darien is 4,475 students.

## Library

Darien Library is a Library Journal Five Star Library-state of the art and eco-friendly. It has been rated as the best library in CT. Among the busiest public libraries in the state, with over 1,300 people visiting on an average day. We have the highest per capita circulation in Connecticut, with more than 32 items per resident checked out each year, and our Wi-Fi and public computers are used nearly a quarter of a million times a year. There are over 1,500 public events annually, hosting a lineup of bestselling authors, the latest in coding and technology classes, workshops for small business owners and entrepreneurs, story times, art classes, film series, and concerts.
